Are you interested in volunteering to help licensed wildlife rehabilitators with orphaned wildlife? This workshop will cover baby squirrels, raccoons, and rabbits. The cost is \$25.00 per person or \$40.00 for two attendees registering together.

Important Notes: You must be 18 years-old to attend. Before you can volunteer and be sub-permitted with a licensed wildlife rehabilitator, you must check that your community does not have an ordinance against wildlife rehabilitation. Also, the licensed rehabilitator will need to be close enough to you that they can provide you with supervision and mentoring. New FOW volunteers work with bottle-baby animals only. Each attendee will receive a Certificate of Attendance at the end of our workshop.
